In honor of their daughter, Andolyn, the Medina Family is awarding an annual \$100 scholarship to a deserving preteen lady in the Miss Greater Richmond Scholarship Competition. The Medina family strongly believes that volunteerism, community service and helping others are very important in everyday life. They instill this belief in their daughter and demonstrate it by their own personal service in the community.

Here's how to be eligible to win this award:

1. The contestant is required to write a one-page, essay-style summary of her volunteer community activities including specifically what she did, what was accomplished and why she participated. It may be handwritten or typed. Include the dates and locations of each service and also the contestant's name and age.
2. Please put the essay in an envelope or a folder to give it to Sue Cox at the Sunday rehearsals in January. The deadline is Sunday, January 27th. The essays will be given to the MGR Community Service Committee who will decide the winner.
3. The winner will be announced at the Miss Greater Richmond Youth Pageant on Saturday, February 2nd, 2:00 at Deep Run High School. The winner will also be introduced on stage that same night during the Miss Greater Richmond competition.
4. The winner may use the scholarship to continue training in dance, voice, drama, musical instruments, etc. Submit an invoice from the teacher or the school and prompt payment will be made directly to them.
