The Central Virginia Foodbank serves 31 counties and 5 cities. Of critical importance is stopping childhood hunger. The Kids Café provides a balanced evening meal and snacks for 1,900 at-risk children partnering with after-school programs. The CVFB provides 4,000 meals each weekday for low-income youngsters. They serve children, elderly, disabled, newly unemployed, mentally challenged, homeless, working poor, battered women, victims of natural disasters and single-parent families.

How We Can Help

Beginning with the Contestant Orientation Luncheon on January 6th and continuing each Sunday in January, please bring-in your groceries for our Foodbank box. Dress rehearsal night and pageant day, we will accept food donations at the door. If you are attending our pageants on February 2nd at 2:00 and 7:00, you may bring food donations to the school. The week after the pageant, the new winners will deliver the boxes of food collected to the Virginia Food Bank as their first community service project.

Specific items needed are canned juices, meats, fruits and vegetables, boxed cereals, rice and pasta noodles, paper products-paper towels, napkins and toilet paper, snacks - nabs, nuts, chips and bottled water.
