To create and maintain a system of competition which enhances career opportunities and to produce role models representing positive wholesome American values;

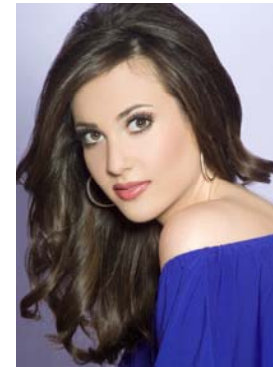
